## ATWATER BOMBERS GROUND RULES -MAJOR/MINOR DIVISION



- 1. There will be ten (10) defensive players. A team may start a game with eight (8) players.
- 2. Each player on the team roster will participate in a minimum of six (6) consecutive defensive outs. Batting lineup will consist of a continuous batting order. Players must have at least one (1) at bat.
- 3. Players may enter and re-enter defensively in the game anytime, provided they meet the requirements of mandatory play.
- 4. **Stealing** is allowed at all bases.
- 5. **Sliding** is allowed except at first base, if a batter/runner slides at first base he/she will be out. *Exception: Head-first sliding/diving is allowed only when* returning to a base (including first base). There is **NO** "leading off" the base, and the <u>pitch must cross home plate</u> before a runner leaves the base.
- 6. A **relief pitcher** is allowed to warm up on the inside of the fence <u>only</u>, in a safe area for the pitcher and catcher so that no one gets hit by a foul ball; it must also be a safe area for bystanders and fans. Managers or coaches are permitted to warm up a pitcher at home plate or in the bullpen or elsewhere at any time including in-game warm-up, pre-game warm-up, and in other instances. They may also stand by to observe a pitcher during warm-up in the bullpen.
- 7. There is a maximum play time limit of one (1) hour 45 minutes; and no new inning may start if there are only 5 minutes left in the game. Open Innings are at the discretion of the umpire,
  - **Suspended Rescheduled Games** The suspended and rescheduled game will resume play from the exact point that the game was suspended. The suspended/ rescheduled game will ONLY be replayed using eligible players from the original game date.
  - The rescheduled game will follow all pitch count and days of rest rules; therefore, the pitcher of record may not be eligible to pitch during the rescheduled game if their recent pitch totals from regular scheduled games prohibit them from pitching.
  - **Playoff or Championship Games** the one (1) hour 45-minute time limit rule does not apply to any playoff or championship games. Playoff and championship games may not end with a tie score.
- 8. Home teams will always be on the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) base side.

- 9. The **courtesy runner** is in effect for the catcher. The offensive coach may elect to utilize a courtesy runner for the catcher whenever there are two (2) outs, the runner who comes into the game must be the player who made the last out.
- 10. **Mercy Rule** will apply as follows:

8 runs after 5 innings (4  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) if the home team is ahead.

10 runs after 4 innings (3  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) if the home team is ahead.

15 runs after 3 innings (2  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) if the home team is ahead.

11. **Stealing or relaying of signs** to alert the batter of pitch selection and/or locations is unsportsmanlike behavior, and if in the judgement of the umpire the behavior is occurring the following penalties will apply:

1<sup>st</sup> offense: Offending person or player and Head Coach will receive a warning.

2<sup>nd</sup> offense: Offending person or player and Head Coach will be immediately ejected,

and subject to additional sanctions deemed necessary by the Atwater

Bombers Board of Directors.

- 12. **THROWN BAT RULE**: Batter who throws the bat will receive a one-time warning about the danger of throwing the bat. If the same batter throws the bat a second time, the batter will be called out.
- 13. **BUNTING** is allowed.
- 14. THERE IS NO DROPPED THIRD STRIKE RULE.
- 15. BATS: Only USA/USSA bats with a 10/8 drop, and a bat barrel diameter that does NOT exceed 2 5/8 inches may be used for Major/Minor Division games.
- 16. **5 Run Rule:** Teams can score no more than five (5) runs each inning.
- 17. PITCHING: 8 yr olds maximum 2 innings in a single game and 1 days rest.

9-11 yr olds 1 inning 0 days rest

2 innings 1 days rest

3 innings 2 days rest

There is a maximum of 3-innings pitched in a single game.

NOTE: In addition to and outside of these Ground Rules CIF/NFHS\* rules may apply.
